Comments from the public on Agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments on other matters not appearing on the Agenda that are within the Board's subject matter jurisdiction will be heard during the Public Comment period. GRIEVANCE PROCESS: A stakeholder or group of stakeholders may present a grievance concerning the legality of actions by the Board during public comment. Substantive grievances will be examined by a panel set by the Board, and the decisions may be appealed to the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment. PUBLIC ACCESS OF RECORDS In compliance with Government Code Section 54957.5, non-exempt writings that are distributed to a majority or all of the Board in advance of its meetings, may be viewed at the Board meeting.
