Dear Congressman Sherman ,

The Valley Alliance of Neighborhood Councils (VANC) asks that the following action adopted by VANC at their meeting of July 8, 2010, be put on the public record.

**Motion: Be it resolved** that the Valley Alliance of Neighborhood Councils joins the more than 4.9 million citizens and members of Veterans' Service Organizations (VSOs) including the DAV, American Legion and VFW, RPLAC, and others to **OPPOSE** the two 75-year Enhanced Use Leases targeting buildings #4 and #5 and 7.05 acres of land at the VA's Sepulveda Ambulatory Care Center in the San Fernando Valley.

**Be it further resolved** that, both 75 year enhanced use leases must be rescinded; that Sepulveda VA buildings #4 and #5 be immediately restored to fully functioning medical facilities seeing and treating Veteran patients; and that a full service inpatient medical center be rebuilt on the Sepulveda VA property.
