

Northridge or North Hills?

Should Woodley Hill Change to Northridge?



Community Renaming Application

The City of Los Angeles is considering an application to rename a portion of North Hills to Northridge. The area in question is commonly known locally as “Woodley Hill” and is between Lassen Street on the North, Plummer Street on the South, Woodley Avenue on the East and Bull Creek Wash on the West. According to City Records there are references dating back to 1950 for Northridge and 1986 for North Hills.

Advocates in the Woodley Hill section petitioned to rename the community because “our issues and property values relate more to Northridge than North Hills”. This requested name change must be considered and approved or rejected by the full Los Angeles City Council. The North Hills West Neighborhood Council needs your input to help inform the City Council of the community impact.
