To Whom It May Concern:

At a publicly noticed meeting of the Board of Directors of the City of Los Angeles, North Hills West Neighborhood Council, a quorum of six board members voted unanimously today to support the Chase Street Neighborhood Stormwater Greenway project application.

This project proposes to divert, treat and store urban runoff from the channelized bed of the Bull Creek Flood Control Channel for eventual re-use in irrigation and infiltration. Bull Creek is a tributary of the Los Angeles River, flowing north to south through the central San Fernando Valley. The project location is approximately 1/3 of a mile north of the intersection of Roscoe Boulevard and Balboa Boulevard, within the city of Los Angeles in the community of North Hills.

Besides the environmental benefits to our community, an improved "Green Street" along Chase Street and pocket park at the intersection of Bull Creek Channel is much needed. An improved, environmentally friendly streetscape and park at the intersection with Bull Creek Channel would be of great benefit to North Hills West.

We therefore support this project application and urge the California Natural Resources Agency to provide full funding for this project.
